

Ugly Fabric Quilt Rules

Bring your ugly quilt to the general meeting on Sunday August 3rd.

Finished size should be roughly 20 x 24 inches.

Requirements:

Three layers – top, batting, and backing

Quilting – there must be some quilting on the quilt

Edges must be finished

All seven fabrics must be used in the quilt top. You may use the right side and/or the wrong side of any fabric. You do not need to use the entire piece of each fabric but you must use some of each.

You may include one background fabric and one additional fabric.

Note: if you were in the group of six and only have six fabrics, you may add two fabrics plus one background fabric.

Embellish as you wish.

Do not label the quilt.

Notes:

This is intended to be a “blind” viewer’s choice. Do not include anything that would identify who made the quilt.

Each member in attendance will receive one free ticket to vote on the quilt of her choice. Additional tickets may be purchased at \$1.00 per ticket.

When voting is complete, votes will be tallied.

In the event of a tie, someone who does not have a quilt in the contest will cast the tie-breaking vote. Her decision is final.

The quilt with the most votes will win first prize which is \$100.00.
Second prize is \$50.00.

Remember what Bonnie Hunter says: If the fabric is still ugly, you haven't cut it small enough.
